Instructor Level Fact Sheet

Instructors provide professional development to individuals, training groups of adults who work with children and families. Training content must fall within one or more of the eight Early Childhood Core Knowledge Areas or the five Afterschool Core Knowledge Areas. Instruction is planned, documented, and interactive group learning experience among adults, led by a qualified instructor to meet specific learning objectives. It is responsive to the needs and interests of the learner and learning outcomes for individuals are assessed.

For the purpose of the Instructor Registry, you're allowed to count instructional experience that meets the description below. You can include hours of one to-one instruction between an instructor and a single learner, however they cannot equal more than half of the total hours required for that Instructor Level.
