Northern Lights by the Numbers

- 3604 career advising contacts
- 1217 contacts providing support with BFIS accounts
- 1064 college transcripts coded and entered into BFIS
- 7161 related college courses entered into BFIS
- 189,526 hits to the Northern Lights website
- 9931 Individuals submitted PD documents
- 36,396 total documents were received by individuals
- 67% of the documents received met the criteria to be added to BFIS accounts

Northern Lights Covid-19 Response

- 81 Online Real-Time (ORT) trainings offered 4/1-6/30-20
- 2344 individual training registrations for ORT trainings
- 94% participant satisfaction rate for ORT trainings
- Rapid development and transition to ORT trainings
- Support for trainers + sponsors with ORT training delivery
- PD-related resource hub during Covid-19

2020 Survey of the Field

• 353 survey respondents

- Diversity in experience; majority respondents 11+ years in the field
- Diversity of roles; majority respondents center-based staff, center-based administrators, family child care professionals
- 80% are able to find the trainings they need (up 13%)
 74% are able to find trainings that meet their level (up 13%)
 77% are able to find trainings to appeal to their interests (up 10%)

- Leadership-focused 51% [179]
- Infant/Toddler-focused 42% [145]
- Director-focused 37% [130]
- Family Child Care-focused 31% [107]
