BACKGROUND

- Program started in 1975
- Adult students started to enroll in colleges
- One assessment program: portfolio preparation
- Nearly 8,000 students

- Focused Portfolio Development

Two fast options

- CCV Course Challenge
- Credit by Examination



PORTFOLIO COURSES

Assessment of Prior Learning (APL)

- EDU-1240, 3-credit course
- Meets 15 weeks, once per week
 - Evening/Saturday/Fully online options
- No credit request limit
- No curricular area limitations
- \$1240 with fees for in-state residents
- Students can only take the course once TRANSFER CREDIT

PORTFOLIO COURSES

Focused Portfolio Development

- EDU-1225, 1-credit course
- Meets six times in eight weeks
 - Evening/Saturday/Fully online options
- 16-credit request limit
- Requests must be in same curricular area
- Cost: \$580 with fees for in-state residents
- Students can submit supplemental portfolio without re-taking the course evaluation fee (\$200)

TIME/COST SAVINGS

- Credit by Examination
 - **150-600 hours/\$700-\$3,000**
 - 3-12 credits
- Course Challenge
 - **100** hours/\$500-\$700
 - 1-4 credits
- Focused Portfolio Development
 - 500 hours/\$3,000
 - Average 12 credits/90%
- Assessment of Prior Learning
 - **1**,000 hours/\$8,000
 - Average 30 credits/75%

Each 3 cr course = ~150 hours of class/homework time & \$900


