

Professional Development Survey of the Field Summer 2021

Each summer, Northern Lights at CCV surveys members of the early childhood and afterschool workforce to better understand their professional development needs and preferences. This document includes a summary of key results from this survey. The complete data set including open responses is available to ECPDS partners upon request.

There were 187 respondents to this survey during July and August 2021.

Context Note: We expected a response rate of roughly double the rate we saw in 2021. We believe the response rate was limited by several factors including the likelihood of "survey burnout" during the past 18 months. All data below should be considered within the context of this limited sample size.


How likely are you to participate in the following types of trainings in the next year?


