

Professional Development Survey of the Field Summer 2023

Each summer, Northern Lights at CCV surveys members of the early childhood and afterschool workforce to better understand their professional development needs and preferences. This document includes a summary of key results from this survey. The complete data set including open responses is available to ECPDS partners upon request.

There were 210 respondents to this survey during June and July, 2023.

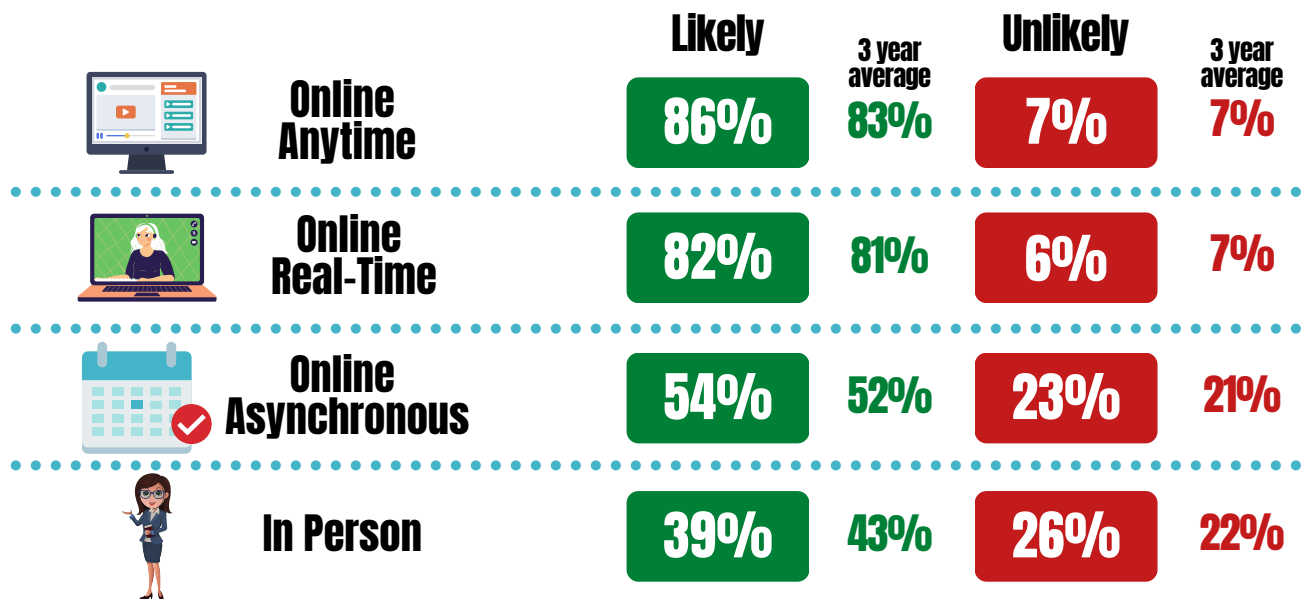

- 74% I look for trainings on topics that are new to me
- 66% I choose trainings based on the day and/or time of the training
- 59% I look for training that addresses the age group I teach
- 59% I watch the training calendars and sign up when something interests me
- 54% I choose topics related to the goals in my IPDP

- 70% I search the Northern Lights Training Calendar
- 41% I hear about trainings from my director or colleagues
- 36% I hear about trainings from my Vermont Early Childhood Network
- 35% I hear about trainings in the CDD professional development newsletter
